France July 4-1918

Dear Mother.

This is the coldest 4th of July I ever saw. France sure is cold in parts in the summer. Some time ago we were in a town with a beautiful Cathedral in it and every night from 8 to 9 P. M. one of the soldiers from New York would play the pipe organ. It certainly was beautiful and I was sorry when we had to leave that place. Everywhere we go we see the tall spires of the churches, but some have been partly destroyed by German bombs.

July 5-

We had all day yesterday to ourselves at 9 A.M. The French held services in the Church nearby for our 4th of July. I ask well your letter of May 12th is the last one I have received.
