Nov 19 - 1918

Dear Mother,

Am still here in the rest Camp. All of my mail must be with "C" Co. of the 102 U.S. Engineers as I have not received any since Oct. 15th wish I could have been in old New York to see the demonstration when the armistice was signed.

The French had a big time here and on Sunday the 17th they had another celebration.

Weather here fair makes ice some mornings. Hope you and dad are well. Guess the Germans think more of the "Yanks" than they did at first. Remember me to all and hoping to be home soon will say good-bye.
